


Cabaret! 2026 Info Doc

Event Summary

Cabaret is a musical theater themed fundraiser with dessert included in your ticket, performances from the choirs and individual solos, duets, and trios, and a silent auction. It is our biggest fundraiser of the year and our only required whole-group event fundraiser.

Other Quick Facts:

- Students wear their choir t-shirt (will be distributed 1/30) and jeans without rips, solid colored clean shoes
- **All choir students are required to attend, including set up, performance/event, and clean up**
- Cost is \$10 gen admission, \$5 students with ASB/seniors to attend
- **All students are also finding donations for the silent auction**
- Choir Council will MC the night
- It will be held in the Mead High School mall (commons)



Event Day Schedule

2:45-3:30	Set up call 1 - sound (Choir Council + volunteers)
3:30-4:00	Buffer/break for Campbell to mix sound
4:00-5:30	Set up call 2 - chairs, tables, decor (Choir Council + volunteers)
4:30	Solo/duet/trio acts & MCs (Choir Council) call Fundraiser set up crew (Boosters & parent volunteers) call
5:45	Choirs & Cedric call Find spots, sound check, warm up, run through each individual choir's song
6:30	Silent Auction opens - ticket sales open (basically, what we normally call our "doors open" time)
6:35	Green room (choir students meet in choir room)
6:45	Concert starts
7:15ish	Intermission; close of some silent auction/raffle items and announcement of winners
8:00ish	Concert ends; close and announcement of remaining silent auction/raffle items
9:00	Students dismissed <u>when clean up is complete</u>
